Re : Sodium Cyclamate and Foods Containing Sodium Cyclamate.

NOTIFICATION OF THE MINISTRY OF PUBLIC HEALTH

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Whereas it appears that certain countries have recognized the usage of sodium cyclamate as sugar substitute, it is therefore deemed appropriate to allow the manufacture thereof for export.

By virtue of Section 5, Section 6(1), (2), (4), (5) and (10) of the Foods Act B.E. 2522(1979), the Minister of Public Health hereby notifies that:

No. 1. Sodium cyclamate and foods containing sodium cyclamate shall be specifically controlled food.

No. 2. Sodium cyclamate shall have the following qualities or standards :

- (1) Contains not less than 98 percent of sodium cyclamate.
- (2) Loss on drying not more than 1 percent, when dried at 105 degrees celcius.
- (3) Heavy metals (calculated as lead) not more than 10 mg./1 kg.
- (4) Silinium contents not more than 30 mg./1 kg.
- (5) Cyclohexylamine contents not more than 100 mg./1 kg.

No. 3. Foods containing sodium cyclamate shall have the qualities or standards as approved by the Food and Drug Administration.

No. 4. The foods under this Notification shall be manufactured for export only, whereby evidences showing that orders have been placed for export shall be produced to the Food and Drug Administration, and the manufacturer shall prepare the label in foreign language for export purposes only.

This Notification shall be enforced on and from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
