Re : Standards of Food Contaminated with
Radioactivity (No.2).

* * * * *

Whereas it is deemed expedient to amend the practice in issuing certificate of safety concerning the stating of level of radioactive quantity so that it be more suitable,

By virtue of Section 5 and Section 6(3) of the Food Act B.E.2522(1979), the Minister of Public Health hereby notifies that :

No. 1. The provisions of No. 3 of the Notification of the Ministry of Public Health No. 102¹ (B.E.2529(1986)) Re Standards of Food Contaminated with Radioactivity dated 18th November 1986 shall be repealed and replaced by the following :

"No. 3. For the purpose of control of food under No.1, specifically those imported into the Kingdom, the Food and Drug Administration shall have the power to prescribe categories and types of food the importers thereof must produce a certificate of safety stating the level of quantity of radioactivity in the form of Cesium-137 (Cs-137) of such food, which is issued by :

- (1) Authority of the country of origin, or
- (2) Private institute recognized by the Authority of the country of origin, whereby the said certificate shall be produced at the Customs House where the food is imported."

This Notification shall be enforced on and from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
