



## LAND (REMOVAL OF SAND) REGULATIONS

*Made by the Queen in Council on 27th March, 1936*

*G. 89/36, G. 367/78, G. 17/83*

1. These regulations may be cited as The Land (Removal of Sand) Regulations.
2. The taking or removal of sand from the foreshore other than the foreshore within the limits of any harbour without a permit in writing signed by the Minister is prohibited.
3. The taking or removal of sand from Crown land or any other holding without a permit in writing signed by the Minister is prohibited. (*Substituted, G. 17/83.*)
4. Any person who, without a permit from the Minister, takes or removes any sand from the foreshore or from any other place from which the taking or removal of sand is prohibited without such permit as aforesaid, and any person who allows sand to be taken or removed from any such place, except by a person who has obtained a permit as aforesaid, shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$100, and in default of payment to a period of imprisonment not exceeding 3 months.
