PROCLAMATION OF NOXIOUS WEEDS BY THE PRIME MINISTER

(1) On 20th August, 1926

R.R. 17/29

Name of plant—

Cactus (Cactaceae)

Area to which the proclamation extends—

The Kingdom of Tonga.

(2) On 12th February, 1927

R.R. 16/29

Name of plant—

Johnson Grass, commonly known as Hana or Kola.

Area to which the proclamation extends—

All land and islands in the District of Ha'apai and Vava'u

(3) On 26th August, 1929

G. 121/29

Name of plant—

Johnson Grass known also as Hana or Kola.

Area to which the proclamation extends—

Niuatoputapu and Tafahi

(4) On 27th October, 1933

G. 150/33

Name of plant —

Blue rat tail (*Stachytarpheta Indica*) or Fisi Lanumata.

Area to which the proclamation extends—

The whole of Tonga.

(5) On 25th October, 1968

G. 106/68

Name of plant —

Prickly Solanum (*Solanum Torvum*) commonly known as Tisaipale.

Area to which the proclamation extends—

The whole of Tonga.
