



Ministerial Decree Number (437) of the year 2005
On allowing the importation of Hatching Eggs, Parents
Stocks and Layers of one day old

Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries,

Having examined the federal law No. (1) of the year 1972 on the functions of the Ministries and the powers vested upon the Ministers and the laws issued in amendment thereof,

And the Federal Law No. (6) of the year 1979 on the veterinary quarantine and the laws issued in amendment thereof,

And the Cabinet Resolution No. (18) of the year 2004 on the Organizational Structure of the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries,

And the Ministerial Decree (460) of the year 2001 on the Executive By- Law of the quarantine system in the GCC countries,

And by virtue of the By-Law of the International Organization for Animal Health (OIE) relating to the importation of Hatching Eggs, Parents Stocks and Layers of one day old,

And according to the recommendations of the National Contingency Secretariat to follow up Avian Flu Disease in the country,

And upon the necessities of the public interest,

Has decided the following:



Article (1)

It shall be permissible to import hatching eggs, parents stocks and layers of one day old from the countries where no infectious cases of Avian Flu Disease were reported provided that:

- 1- Obtaining prior import permit from the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries.
- 2- Fulfill the conditions of importation as stated in the By- Law of the International Organization of Animal Health (OIE).

Article (2)

The Animal Wealth Department shall coordinate with the competent authorities in the country to enforce this Decree.

Article (3)

The concerned bodies shall implement the provisions of this Decree each upon his jurisdiction, and shall be enforced as from the date of its issuance and shall be published in the official Gazette.
