**The Game (Central Karamoja Hunting Area) Order.**

*(Sections 71 and 72 of the Act).*

1. (1) THIS ORDER may be cited as the Game (Central Karamoja Hunting Area) Order.

(2) This Order shall apply to the area specified in the First Schedule to this Order, other than such part thereof as has been declared to be a game reserve known as the Matheniko Game Reserve.

2. The hunting of any species of scheduled animals specified in the Second Schedule to this Order is hereby prohibited.

3. In respect of any species of scheduled animals specified in the first column of the Third Schedule to this Order the number of each of such species which may be hunted in any one calendar year shall be the number respectively set out in the second column of such Schedule.

4. It is hereby prescribed that on the issue of a permit to hunt any species of the scheduled animals specified in the Third Schedule to this Order there shall be paid to the Karamoja District Administration the basic fee as specified in that Schedule and, in addition, the fee respectively specified in respect of each of such species in the third, fourth and fifth columns of that Schedule.

5. It is hereby declared that a request in writing has been received from the Karamoja District Administration to prescribe the fees specified in the fifth column of the Third Schedule to this Order in respect of permits issued to *bona fide* residents of the Karamoja District.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

para. 1.

The area comprised within the following boundaries—

Commencing at the point where the Kitgum—Loyoro road crosses the Karamoja—Acholi District boundary; thence in an easterly direction following the Kitgum—Loyoro road to Loyoro; thence in an easterly direction to the mountain peak called Thokotukei (5,916 feet) on the Uganda—Kenya boundary; thence in a southerly direction following the Uganda—Kenya boundary to the point where the Moroto—Nakiloru—Lodwar road crosses the Uganda—Kenya boundary; thence in a south-westerly direction following the Lodwar—Nakiloru—Moroto road to Moroto; thence in a south-westerly direction following the Moroto—Soroti road to its junction with the Adilang road; thence in a westerly direction following the Moroto—Adilang road to the point where it crosses the Karamoja—Acholi District boundary; thence in a northerly direction following the Karamoja—Acholi District boundary to the point of commencement.
