## SEA FISHERIES (BAIE NY CARRICKEY CLOSED AREA) REGULATIONS 2013

*Laid before Tynwald:* 10 December 2013  
*Coming into Operation:* 1 November 2013

The Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture makes the following Regulations under section 36 of the Fisheries Act 2012, having complied with section 83(2) and (5) of that Act.

### 1 Title

These Regulations are the Sea Fisheries (Baie ny Carrickey Closed Area) Regulations 2013.

### 2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 1 November 2013.

### 3 Interpretation

In these Regulations —

“**the Baie ny Carrickey closed area**” means that part of the Irish Sea to the North of the line on the map in the Schedule, up to, and including, the shore of Baie ny Carrickey to the mean high water mark;

“**queen scallop**” means fish of the species *Aequipecten opercularis*;

“**scallop**” means fish of the species *Pecten maximus*.

### 4 Fishing restrictions

No person shall fish for, take or kill scallops or queen scallops in the Baie ny Carrickey closed area by any means.



These Regulations prohibit the fishing for or taking of scallops or queen scallops in the Baie ny Carrickey (Port St Mary Bay) closed area by any means.

Contravention of these Regulations is an offence under sections 36(4) and 41 of the Fisheries Act 2012.
