

117/2007/ND-CP of July 11, 2007, on clean water production, supply and consumption; and Decree No. 124/2011/ND-CP of December 28, 2011, amending and supplementing a number of articles of the Government's Decree No. 117/2007/ND-CP;

At the proposal of the director of the Department of Price Management;

The Minister of Finance promulgates the daily-life clean water selling price frame as follows:

Article 1. To promulgate together with this Circular the daily-life clean water selling price frame.

Article 2. Pursuant to Joint Circular No. 75/2012/TTLT-BTC-BXD-BNN of May 15, 2012, of the Ministry of Finance, the Ministry of Construction, and the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, guiding the principles and methods of determining, and competence to decide on, clean water selling prices in urban centers, industrial parks and rural areas, provincial-level People's Committees shall decide specific daily-life clean water selling prices in accordance with Article 1 of this Circular.

Article 3. This Circular takes effect on July 11, 2012, and replaces the Ministry of Finance's Circular No. 100/2009/TT-BTC of May 20, 2009, on clean water production, supply and consumption.-

Daily-life clean water selling price frame

Category	Minimum price (VND/m³)	Maximum price (VND/m³)
Special urban centers and grade-I urban centers	3,500	18,000
Urban centers of grades II, III, IV and V	3,000	15,000
Rural daily-life clean water	2,000	11,000

Note: The above prices are inclusive of value-added tax.
