CIRCULAR

PROMULGATION OF HS CODES OF COMMODITIES UNDER MANAGEMENT OF MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT AND IMPORTS AND EXPORTS SUBJECT TO SPECIALIZED INSPECTION IN THE FIELD OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT

Pursuant to the Government's Decree No. 15/2017/ND-CP dated February 17, 2017 defining functions, tasks, powers and organizational structure of the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development;

Pursuant to the Government's Decree No. 69/2018/ND-CP dated May 15, 2018 elaborating some articles of the Law on foreign trade management;

Pursuant to the Government's Decree No. 85/2019/ND-CP dated November 14, 2019 on handling of administrative procedures via national single window and ASEAN single-window system and specialized inspection for imports and exports;

At the request of the Director of the Legal Department, Director General of Directorate of Fisheries, Director General of the Vietnam Administration of Forestry, Directors of Plant Protection Department, Department of Husbandry, Animal Health Department, Department of Cultivation, Cooperatives and Rural Development Department;

The Minister of Agriculture and Rural Development promulgates a Circular promulgating HS codes of commodities under management of Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development and imports and exports subject to specialized inspection in the field of agriculture and rural development.

Article 1. The following Annexes are enclosed with this Circular:

Article 2. Effect

1. This Circular comes into force from November 06, 2021.

2. This Circular supersedes the Circular No. [15/2018/TT-BNNPTNT](#) dated October 29, 2018 of the Minister of Agriculture and Rural Development promulgating list of HS codes of commodities under management of Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development.

Article 3. Responsibility for implementation

1. Chief of the Ministry's Office, Director of the Legal Department, heads of units and agencies affiliated to the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, and relevant authorities, organizations and individuals shall be responsible for the implementation of this Circular.

2. Difficulties that arise during the implementation of this Circular should be promptly reported to the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development for consideration./.
