The Co-operative Societies Act (Act No. 20 of 1998)

The Co-operative Societies Regulations, 1999

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-three* of the Co-operative Societies Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires—</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">"Registrar" means the Registrar of Co-operatives appointed under section <i>six</i>;</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">"co-operative" means any enterprise or organisation owned collectively by its members and managed for their joint socio-economic benefit and whose activities are not prohibited by law; and</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">"co-operative society" means a co-operative registered under this Act as a co-operative society.</p> | <p>Interpretation</p> |
| <p>3. A co-operative shall apply for registration in Form 1 set out in the First Schedule upon payment of the fee prescribed in the Second Schedule.</p> | <p>Application for registration</p> |
| <p>4. The Registrar shall, upon registration of a co-operative issue a certificate of registration in Form 2 set out in the First Schedule.</p> | <p>Certificate of registration</p> |
| <p>5. Where the Registrar refuses to register a co-operative, notification of the refusal shall be in Form 3 set out in the First Schedule.</p> | <p>Notice of refusal to register</p> |
| <p>6. Where the Registrar is satisfied that a co-operative society's amendments to its by-laws are in conformity with the provisions of the Act, the Registrar shall issue a certificate of amendment to the by-laws in Form 4 set out in the First Schedule.</p> | <p>Certificate of Amendment</p> |
| <p>7. (1) Where a co-operative society changes its name the</p> | <p>Change of name by co-operative society</p> |

co-operative society shall surrender its original certificate of registration to the Registrar.

(2) Where a certificate is surrendered under sub-regulation (1), the Registrar shall issue a new certificate of registration.

8. Where the Registrar cancels the registration of a co-operative society under subsection (1) of section *eighty-one* of the Act, the Registrar shall give notice of the cancellation in writing to the co-operative society in Form 5 set out in the First Schedule.

9. An application for membership in a co-operative shall be in Form 6 as set out in the First Schedule.

10. The fees specified in the Second Schedule are payable in respect of the matters mentioned therein.
