**The Fisheries (Fishing Licence Fees) Regulations, 1991**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *twenty-one* of the Fisheries Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

| 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Fishing Licence Fees) Regulations, 1991.  | Title                              |
| 2. The fee payable in respect of a Special Fishing Licence shall be the appropriate fee set out in the First Schedule hereto.   | Special licence fee                |
| 3. The fee payable in respect of a fishing licence issued for the purpose of fishing in a commercial fishing area shall be the appropriate fee set out in the Second Schedule hereto.   | Fishing licence fee                |
| 4. The Minister may, where he considers it desirable in the interest of developing the fish industry so to do, in respect of any person obtaining a licence for the first time, remit or reduce by such amount as he thinks fit, any of the fees required to be paid under these Regulations. | Remission of fees                  |
| The Fisheries (Fishing Licence Fee) Regulations, 1989, are hereby revoked.  | Revocation of S.I. No. 172 of 1989 |
