IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in Regulation 9 of the Mines and Minerals (Environmental) Regulations, 1997 the following Order is hereby made:

| 2. The developer set out in the Schedule to this Order is exempted from the provisions of the Mines and Minerals (Environmental) Regulations for the period specified therein. | Exemption from environmental regulations

| 3. (1) The exemption granted under paragraph 2 is subject to the condition that the developer shall operate in accordance with an Environmental Management Plan developed and agreed upon between the developer and the Director. | Conditions of exemption |
| (2) Where the developer fails or neglects to comply with the condition set out in sub-paragraph (1) the provisions of the Mines and Minerals (Environmental) Regulations shall apply and be invoked by the Director. | S.I. No. 29 of 1997 |
