The National Parks and Wildlife Act
(Laws, Volume 12, Cap. 201)

**The National Parks and Wildlife (Licences and Fees)
(Amendment) Regulations, 1997**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in sections *sixty-two* and *one hundred and eighty-five* of the National Parks and Wildlife Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These regulations may be cited as the National Parks and Wildlife (Licences and Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 1997, and shall be read as one with the National Parks and Wildlife (Licences and Fees) Regulations in 1993, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations are amended by the deletion of the Second Schedule and the substitution therefor of the Second Schedule set out in the Appendix to these Regulations.

Notes:

- (i) Capture of any species of a game animal for the purpose of keeping such a species of a game animal in captivity within Zambia by non-Zambian shall be purchased by auction or tender.
- (ii) No more than five game animals of different species of which no more than one animal per species may be purchased from the Table under a national game licence.
- (iii) Game animal fees in the District Game Licence column will apply to any citizen of Zambia who is a *bona fide* resident of a District Council area where the animals are to be purchased and hunted.

- (iv) Any additional animal of any one species, when available on quota, shall be sold at 50 per centum more than the indicated price.
- (v) Purchase of any second or subsequent game animal of the same species by any *bona fide* client of a safari hunting company shall be restricted to the following game animals:
 1. Impala;
 2. Duiker, C;
 3. Oribi;
 4. Warthog;
 5. Grysbok; or
 6. Baboon;

Notes:

- (i) These animals may be bought from the special licence list.
- (ii) Not all the animals listed here will be available on quota or special licence.
- (iii) Capture of any species of a protected animal for the purpose of keeping such a protected animal in captivity within Zambia will be purchased at 50 per centum of the prescribed fee for such an animal in column 1.
- (iv) Capture of any animal listed above for the purpose of export shall be charged at the appropriate fee indicated for such an animal in the third column but payment shall be made in kwacha.
- (v) Capture of any animal listed above on any land which is set aside as a game ranch or farm for the purpose of keeping such an animal in captivity within such land shall be purchased at 50 per centum of the prescribed fee for such an animal in column 1.
- (vi) Any additional animal of any species, when available on quota, shall be sold at 50 per centum more than the indicated price except all species of lechwe.

Provided that the above restriction shall not apply to any *bona fide* client of a safari hunting company who is not accompanied by any other person other than his spouse or children on his hunting safari.

- (vi) A lion or a leopard shall not be available on a national game licence valid for any game management area for which there is a valid safari hunting rights agreement.

- (vii) In these notes "established resident" means any holder of a Certificate of status as an established resident issued under section thirty-three of the Immigration and Deportation Act.

(vii) No more than two animals of any species may be purchased from this Table except all species of lechwe.

(viii) Purchase of any second or subsequent protected animal of the same species shall be restricted to the following species.

1. Black lechwe;
2. Kafue lechwe; or
3. Tsessebe.

(xi) A roan shall not be available on a national game licence valid for any game management area for which there is no valid safari hunting rights agreement.

(x) The following animal species will not be available to non-safari hunters in game management areas but will be available in the open areas:

- (a) leopard;
- (b) lion;
- (c) sable;
- (d) antelope; or roan antelope.

(xi) Fees for overseas clients as shown in columns 4 and 5 in Table 1, and column 3 of Table 2 include, animal fees, export permit fees, game management area permit fees and safari licence basic fee.

(xii) A Safari Licence in respect of a classical or deluxe safari shall authorise the holder to purchase individually, game animals and protected animals listed in Tables 1 and 2 within the quota of animals prescribed for the safari hunting company for which the holder is a hunting client.

(xiii) A Safari Licence in respect of a mini safari shall authorise the holder to purchase individually, up to a maximum of seven animals but these animals shall not include a leopard, lion, sable, antelope, roan antelope or an eland.

(xiv) A Safari Licence in respect of a specialised safari shall authorise the holder to purchase individually, Kafue lechwe, Red lechwe, Black lechwe, Tsessebe and Sitatunga.
