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Minerals Marketing Corporation of Zimbabwe (Exemption) Regulations, 1983

S.I. 111 of 1983

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Mines, has, in terms of section 56 of the Minerals Marketing Corporation of Zimbabwe Act, [Chapter 21:04], made the following regulations:—

Title

Minerals Marketing Corporation of Zimbabwe 1. These regulations may be cited as the Minerals marketing Corporation of Zimbabwe (Exemption) Regulations, 1983.

Interpretation

Minerals Marketing Corporation of Zimbabwe 2. In these regulations—

“general manager” means the general manager appointed in terms of section 24 of the Ac.

Exemption of domestic sales

Minerals Marketing Corporation of Zimbabwe 3. Any producer or other person in possession of any mineral, except those minerals specified in the Schedule is exempted from compliance with the provisions of section 42 and 43 of the Act in respect of any sales within Zimbabwe which are not intended for export.

Exemption from Part IV of the Act

Certificate to be issued

Minerals Marketing Corporation of Zimbabwe 5. Any producer or other person exempted in terms of section 4 shall be issued with a certificate of exemption, signed by the general manager, or his representative.

Cancellation of exemption

Minerals Marketing Corporation of Zimbabwe 6. The general manager may, with the approval of the board, and in writing, cancel any exemption given in terms of these regulations.

Schedule (Section 3)

1. Tantalum ores.
2. Niobium ores.
3. Tungsten ores.
4. Commercial beryl.
5. Tin ores.
6. Precious stones as defined in section 2 of the Precious Stones Trade Act, 1978, and the following semi-precious stones—
 - (i) beryl (including aquamarine, euclase, golden beryl, goshenite, heliodor and morganite);
 - (ii) chrysoberyls of gem quality (including alexandrite and cymophane (cat’s-eye));
 - (iii) rubies;
 - (iv) sapphires;
 - (v) topaz;
 - (vi) tourmalines;
 - (viii) garnets;
 - (viii) quartz (amethyst, citrine).
