

Hazardous Substances and Articles (Group II: General)  
Regulations, 1981

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IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Health has, in terms of section 47 of the Hazardous Substances and Articles Act [*Chapter 322*], made the following regulations:—

*Title*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hazardous Substances and Articles (Group II: General) Regulations, 1981.

*Application*

2. These regulations shall apply in relation to any substance or mixture of substances declared to be a group II hazardous substance in terms of section 16 of the Act:

Provided that these regulations shall not apply to any substance or mixture of substances when used, or manufactured, sold or represented as suitable for use, as a drug or veterinary medicine as defined in the Drugs and Allied Substances Control Act [*Chapter 320*], or any substance referred to in section 28 of that Act, other than a veterinary medicine which is used, or is manufactured, sold or represented as suitable for use, topically for the prevention and control of ectoparasites.

*Interpretation*

3. In these regulations—

“animal” means any domestic or wild animal, bird or fish, but does not include vermin;

“flash-point” means the lowest temperature at which the application of a test-flame causes the vapour at the surface of a liquid to ignite but not to continue to burn, as determined by the Abel closed-cup test method, described in British Standard 3442, Part 2, which may be inspected free of charge at the offices of the Secretary for Health;

“pesticide” means any substance or formulation registered as a pesticide in terms of the Pesticide Regulations, 1977, published in Rhodesia Government Notice 10 of 1977;

“premises licence” means a licence issued in terms of section 23 of the Act in respect of any premises, vehicle, vessel or aircraft licensed for the sale of any group II hazardous substance;

“protective clothing” means—

- (a) clothing made from protective material; and
- (b) face-masks, face-shields, goggles and respirators with appropriate cartridges or canisters; specially designed to afford protection to the wearer from the hazards presented by group II hazardous substances;

“supplier’s licence” means a licence issued to a person to supply a group II hazardous substance in terms of section 23 of the Act;

“veterinary remedy” means any substance or formulation which is used, or is manufactured, sold or represented as suitable for use, topically for the prevention and control of ectoparasites, and which is registered as a stock remedy in terms of the Stock Remedies Regulations, 1977, published in Rhodesia Government Notice II of 1977.

*Supplier of group II hazardous substances licence*

4. (1) Any person who applies for a supplier’s licence shall—
- (a) make application in the form prescribed in the First Schedule; and
  - (b) pay to the Licensing Officer a fee of two dollars:

Provided that, when a supplier’s licence is required for a period of ninety days or less, no such fee shall be payable.

(2) A supplier’s licence shall be in the form prescribed in the Second Schedule, and shall be valid for a period of one year from the date of issue:

Provided that a supplier’s licence may be issued for a period of less than one year.

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(3) When any person wishes to apply for an amendment to a supplier's licence in respect of—

(a) a change of business address; or

(b) the conditions subject to which his licence was issued;

he shall submit the relevant particulars of the proposed amendment, with the licence, to the Licensing Officer.

(4) Where an application in respect of any amendment referred to in subsection (3) has been approved by the Board, the necessary amendment shall be made to the licence, or a new licence may be issued at the discretion of the Licensing Officer.

(5) An application for the renewal of a supplier's licence shall be made in the form prescribed in the Third Schedule, and shall be accompanied by a fee of two dollars and the licence required to be renewed.

(6) When a supplier's licence is renewed, the original licence shall be endorsed to the appropriate effect, or a new licence may be issued at the discretion of the Licensing Officer.

(7) When a person to whom a supplier's licence has been issued notifies the Licensing Officer that such licence has been lost, stolen, destroyed or defaced, or is for some other reason no longer in his possession, the Licensing Officer may, upon payment of a fee of one dollar, issue a duplicate of such licence.

(8) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (b) of subsection (1), not more than two supplier's licences shall be issued without payment of the prescribed fee in any one year.

*Group II hazardous substances premises licence*

5. (1) Any person who applies for a premises licence shall—

(a) make application in the form prescribed in the Fourth Schedule; and

(b) pay to the Licensing Officer a fee of two dollars.

(2) A premises licence shall be in the form prescribed in the Fifth Schedule, and shall be valid for a period of one year from the date of issue:

Provided that, if the occupancy of the premises changes during the currency of the licence, the licence shall be deemed to have expired from the date of change of occupancy.

(3) When any person wishes to apply for an amendment to a premises licence in respect of—

- (a) the name of any supplier recorded on the licence; or
- (b) the addition to the licence of any group II hazardous substance;

he shall submit the relevant particulars of the proposed amendment, with the licence, to the Licensing Officer.

(4) Where an application in respect of any amendment referred to in subsection (3) has been approved by the Board, the necessary amendment shall be made to the licence, or a new licence may be issued at the discretion of the Licensing Officer.

(5) An application for the renewal of a premises licence shall be made in the form prescribed in the Sixth Schedule, and shall be accompanied by a fee of two dollars and the licence required to be renewed.

(6) When a premises licence is renewed, the original licence shall be endorsed to the appropriate effect, or a new licence may be issued at the discretion of the Licensing Officer:

Provided that a new licence shall be issued to a person whose application for the authority referred to in subsection (6) is approved by the Board.

(7) When a person to whom a premises licence has been issued notifies the Licensing Officer that such licence has been lost, stolen, destroyed or defaced, or is for some other reason no longer in his possession, the Licensing Officer may, upon payment of a fee of one dollar, issue a duplicate of such licence.

#### *Labelling.*

6. (1) Subject to the provisions of subsection (2), no person shall sell for use within Zimbabwe a group II hazardous substance listed in the first column of the Eighth Schedule, except when such substance occurs in the form of an ore, unless—

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- (a) the immediate container of such substance, or a label securely affixed to that container, has prominently printed or otherwise marked thereon, immediately below the name or the brand name of the substance, a purple equilateral triangle, and bears within the triangle a skull and cross-bones symbol printed in black occupying one-third of the area of the triangle and the word "DANGER" printed in black in capital letters in bold-face type; and
- (b) the container or its label bears in capital letters in bold-face type—
- (i) immediately below the base of the triangle—
- A. the words of warning appearing in the second column of the Eighth Schedule appropriate to such substance; and
- B. in the case of a substance having a flash-point of—
- I. nought degrees Celsius or less, the words "EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE";
- II. more than nought degrees Celsius but not more than thirty degrees Celsius, the word "FLAMMABLE";
- and
- (ii) the words "KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN"; and
- (iii) the words "TO CAUSE A HAZARD IN THE USE, STORAGE OR DISPOSAL OF THIS SUBSTANCE IS AN OFFENCE";
- and
- (c) the length of each side of the triangle and the type-size of the words of warning referred to in paragraphs (a) and (b) are not less than as specified below in relation to the capacity of the container—

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<i>Capacity of the container</i>	<i>Minimum length of each side of triangle</i>	<i>Minimum type-size of warnings</i>
not exceeding 200 millilitres	20 millimetres	6-point
greater than 200 millilitres but not exceeding 1 litre	30 millimetres	8-point
greater than 1 litre but not exceeding 5 litres	40 millimetres	12-point
greater than 5 litres but not exceeding 25 litres	60 millimetres	18-point
greater than 25 litres	80 millimetres	18-point:

Provided that, in the case of a pesticide or veterinary remedy, the requirement concerning the minimum length of each side of the triangle shall not apply but the triangle shall be of such size as to occupy an area of not less than one-twentieth of the area of the label;

- (d) the container or its label bears in close proximity to the triangle in letters printed from type no smaller, in relation to the capacity of the container, than that specified in paragraph (c)—
- (i) the name and business address of the manufacturer, packer, distributor or seller, as the case may be, responsible for packing and labelling the group II hazardous substance; and
  - (ii) the chemical or common name and the percentage on a mass in mass, mass in volume or volume in volume basis of each hazardous substance which the substance contains; and
  - (iii) any necessary precautionary measures to be observed in handling, storing and using the substance to ensure that the health of human beings or domestic or wild animals, birds or fishes is not endangered; and
  - (iv) any necessary instructions regarding spillage and the safe disposal or use of the empty container; and
  - (v) the toxic or other harmful effects; and

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- (vi) first-aid treatment where applicable; and
- (vii) the name of the specific antidote, if any:

Provided that—

- (i) the information referred to in this paragraph, other than subparagraph (vii), need not be in capital letters or bold-face type;
- (ii) where the requirements of this paragraph require more space than is reasonably available on the container, the prescribed type-size may be reduced to the type-size prescribed for a container in the range of capacities which is next smaller in size, but in no case to a size smaller than six-point;
- (iii) the requirements of subparagraph (i) need not be in close proximity to the triangle;
- (g) the colour of the triangle and any words required to appear on a container or label by this section are in distinct contrast to their background.

(2) A group II hazardous substance contained in a mixture with any substance to which the Hazardous Substances and Articles (Group III: General) Regulations, 1981, apply shall bear the words of warning required by those regulations in the order specified therein in addition to and below the words of warning required by subsection (1):

Provided that this subsection shall not apply to words of warning which denote only a difference in degree of hazard.

(3) Any person who stores a group II hazardous substance, whether for supply to other persons or for his own use, shall comply with the provisions of subsections (1) and (2) unless he displays prominently, either on the container or in the immediate vicinity of the container, notices which clearly indicate the name of the substance and the nature of the hazards involved in exposure to the substance and any necessary precautions and first-aid treatment.

(4) The Board may direct the seller of any group II hazardous substance or any person referred to in subsection (3) to—



- (a) provide such information as it may require concerning any labelling required by this section;
- (b) alter any labelling if, in its opinion, the information provided is inaccurate or incorrect or incomplete or does not conform to the requirements of this section.

(5) Notwithstanding anything herein contained, the Board may grant exemption from one or more of the provisions of this section for such period as it may deem necessary, and subject to such conditions as it may deem fit to impose, and may withdraw any exemption so granted.

#### *Packaging*

7. (1) No person shall pack a group II hazardous substance in a container unless the container and its closure—

- (a) will not react chemically or physically with the substance; and
- (b) are of sufficient strength, under the ordinary risks of handling and transport, to prevent the escape of any of the contents.

(2) No person shall sell from premises required to be licensed in terms of the Act, other than from premises referred to in subparagraph (i) of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 19 of the Act, any group II hazardous substance, except in a closed container, as closed by the manufacturer or other person from whom it was received, unless expressly authorized to do so by his premises licence:

Provided that the provisions of this subsection shall not apply to a person who is engaged in the manufacture or production of any pesticide or veterinary remedy in respect of such pesticide or veterinary remedy.

(3) The Board may direct the seller of a group II hazardous substance to submit for its inspection and approval the container of any group II hazardous substance.

#### *Transportation*

8. Where an outer container of one or more group II hazardous substances, each labelled as required by section 6, is

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consigned for conveyance by public transport by road, the provisions of section 6 shall be deemed to have been complied with if the outer container bears—

- (a) a purple equilateral triangle within which is a skull and cross-bones symbol in black; and
- (b) below the triangle, the words "VERY DANGEROUS POISON" and, if applicable to any hazardous substance in the container, the words "EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE" or "FLAMMABLE" as the case may be, each in a colour contrasting with its background;

of such size as to be conspicuous.

*Sale, handling and use of group II hazardous substances*

9. (1) No person shall store for sale any group II hazardous substance in a manner which—

- (a) affords the public direct access thereto; or
- (b) presents a hazard to any human being or animal; or
- (c) could cause contamination to any food as defined in the Food and Food Standards Act [*Chapter 321*] or to any other article, substance or mixtures of substances which may endanger the health of any human being or animal.

(2) No person shall—

- (a) sell a group II hazardous substance for use; or
- (b) use or store a group II hazardous substance;

in or around a household or any related building, such as a garage, storage-shed or home workshop:

Provided that the Board may grant exemption from the provisions of this subsection for such period as it may deem necessary and subject to such conditions as it may deem fit to impose.

(3) No person shall handle or use, or cause to be handled or used, a group II hazardous substance unless he ensures that—

- (a) all persons involved take all the necessary precautions in the handling or use of that substance, including the wearing of appropriate protective clothing; and
- (b) appropriate measures are taken for the safety of any other person who may be at risk from exposure to that substance; and
- (c) there are immediately available all the requirements for the administration of the appropriate first-aid treatment and that there is immediately available to take the necessary action in the event of an accident a person capable of taking such action.

*Register to be kept by persons licensed to supply group II hazardous substances*

10. (1) Every person licensed to supply a group II hazardous substance shall—

- (a) keep a register of all sales of group II hazardous substances in the form prescribed in the Seventh Schedule for a period of two years from the date of the last entry; and
- (b) require the purchaser of such substance to sign the register.

(2) The provisions of paragraph (b) of subsection (1) shall not apply—

- (a) to a wholesaler who is selling to a person only for the purpose of resale;
- (b) in the case of a sale for the purpose of a trade, business or profession, if the purchaser sends a signed written order which the seller keeps for a period of not less than two years;
- (c) to the sale of any pesticide or veterinary remedy to a person who is engaged in the production of livestock or agricultural or horticultural produce for sale or research purposes, if such person—
  - (i) is in possession of a farmer's licence, issued in terms of the Farmers Licensing and Levy Act

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[*Chapter 109*], or a permit issued by an authority approved by the Board; or

- (ii) signs the register referred to in subsection (1) as soon as reasonably practicable, but in any case not later than fourteen days after the date of the sale.

*Offences*

11. Any person who—

- (a) contravenes any provision of these regulations; or  
(b) causes a hazard to the health of any human being or any animal by failing to exercise all reasonable care in the manufacture, handling, conveyance, storage, use or disposal of any group II hazardous substance;

shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months, or to both such fine and such imprisonment.

*Repeal*

12. The Hazardous Substances and Articles (Group II: General) Regulations, 1979, published in Statutory Instrument 437 of 1979, are repealed.
