

Rhodesia Government Notice No. 969 of 1975.

Parks and Wild Life (Hunting of Crocodiles and Removal of Crocodiles' Eggs) Notice, 1975

IN terms of paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section 48 of the Parks and Wild Life Act, 1975, the Minister of Lands and Natural Resources hereby makes the following notice:—

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Parks and Wild Life (Hunting of Crocodiles and Removal of Crocodiles' Eggs) Notice, 1975.

(2) This notice shall come into operation on the 1st November, 1975, and shall have effect for a period of five years from that date.

2. Except in accordance with the terms and conditions of a permit issued to him by the Director, no person shall—

(a) injure, wilfully disturb or remove the egg of any crocodile; or

(b) hunt or remove any crocodile;

on any island or within fifty metres inland or offshore from the water's edge of any river or lake listed in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE (Section 2)

AREAS WHERE THE HUNTING OF CROCODILES AND THE REMOVAL OF CROCODILES' EGGS IS RESTRICTED

1. The Zambezi River from the Botswana border to the Mozambique border, including Lake Kariba.
2. Either bank of the following rivers for a distance of 20 kilometres from their confluence with the Zambezi River or Lake Kariba—
